Women's Equality Day

commemorates the passage of women's suffrage in the United States and reminds us of the hurdles overcome by the heroic women who faced violence and discrimination to propel the women's movement forward. While this day is the anniversary of the adoption of the 19th Amendment, that law did not guarantee all women the right to vote. Most women of color obtained their franchise with the Voting Rights Act of 1965, after nearly half a century more of struggle.

Women aren't done fighting for equal rights. Today, the wage gap between men and women still impacts women's economic power, and gender-based discrimination still plagues workplaces and business transactions.

Nevada NBW

is a non-partisan, volunteer organization focused on six core issues: Constitutional Equality, Reproductive Rights and Justice, Economic Justice, Racial Justice, LGBTQIA+ Rights, and Ending Violence Against All Women. Our activism includes coalition building, community outreach, education, testimonials, rallies, and much more.

In 2022, we held or attended nearly 40 events (including 4 parades) in 51 days to get out the vote for the Nevada State Equal Rights Amendment - the most inclusive state equal rights amendment in the country. We are proud to say it passed with 62.8% of the votes.

Constitutional Equality

Erica Roth

Erica served as the Deputy General Counsel to Governor Sisolak. She advised the Governor and senior staff on a range of issues, including state and federal constitutional laws. She drafted the Governor's Executive Order protecting individuals seeking abortions from criminal prosecution, which has now passed into law. Currently, Erica serves as the Government Affairs and Appellate attorney for the Washoe County Public Defender's Office where she lobbies for criminal justice reform and constitutional protections at the Nevada Legislature and presents constitutional issues before the Nevada Supreme Court.

Economic Justice **Shanieka Cooper**

Shanieka started in home health care in 2007, after her great aunt became ill. The family wanted to care for their loved one in the comfort and the dignity of their own home. Soon, Shanika became passionate about home health care and decided to pursue it as a career. Shanika moved to Las Vegas in 2016, it soon became apparent that, although her work had a tremendous impact on society, it did not provide enough for her and her three children. Shanika became instrumental in the organizing of home health care workers with SEIU and fought for the passage of AB340 - a law that would provide additional income in the budget to be directly spent on home health care workers. It was signed into law in 2021 by Governor Sisolak.



Ending Violence **Against Women** **Amy-Marie Merrell**

Amy is the Executive Director of the Cupcake Girls. Since 2006, she has been working with domestic violence survivors, as well as in the prevention and aftercare of domestic sex trafficking.

Reproductive Rights & Justice

Jollina Walker


Jollina serves as the director of Grants and Policy with Make It Work Nevada. This legislative session, Jollina worked diligently to get policy passed to increase support to Doulas in the state. She worked with Assemblywoman Shondra Summers-Armstrong to get legislation passed to increase pay rates for Doulas being reimbursed by Medicaid. She is also a strong advocate for Black and Brown families through her non-profit, Kijiji Sisterhood, working to lower Black maternal mortality rates and support breastfeeding.



Racial Justice

Laura Martin

Laura moved to Las Vegas to work with SEIU on electing a president committed to health care for all. She joined Americans for Democratic Action to organize low-income communities of color around kitchen table issues. Laura joined PLAN in 2011 – first as a volunteer, then organizer and communications director. Laura's leadership is on display in her current role as Executive Director. She is the first woman, and first Black person to lead PLAN and PLAN Action in the organization's history.

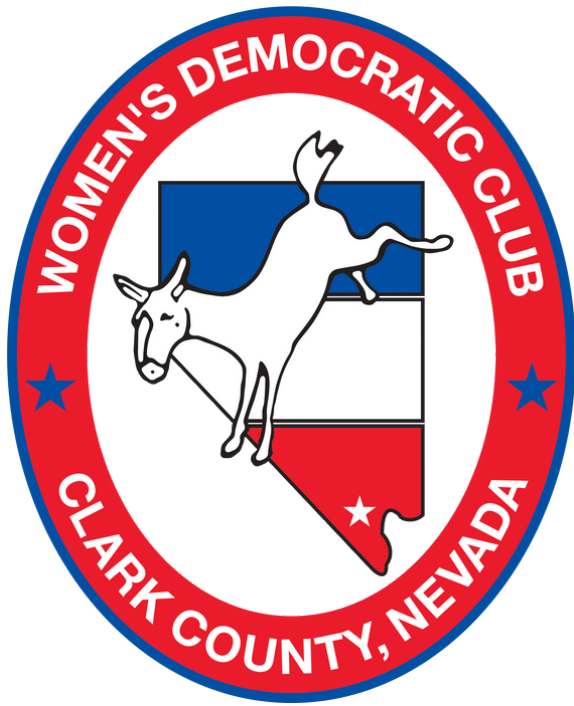
